Lt Gen Himmeth Singh Memorial Golf Tournament

The picturesque fairways of Rambagh Golf Club came alive with competitive spirit and sportsmanship during the LT Gen Himmeth Singh Memorial Golf Tournament – Monthly Medal-I, held on the 29 and 30 March. The event witnessed enthusiastic participation from both professionals and amateurs, with players bringing their A-game to claim top honours.



In the Pro Category, Girraj Singh Khadka emerged as the Pro-Gross Winner with a stellar score of 141, while Abhyuday Rawat followed closely as the Runner-Up at 143. Among the amateurs, Mohit Gothwal claimed the title of Amateur-Gross Winner with a fantastic round of 141, edging past Abhay Malawat, who secured the Runner-Up spot with a score of 144.

Apart from the Gross winners, notable performances were seen across all handicap categories. Arjun Kuchhal, Rohit Swami, and Dhrishavraj emerged winners in the 00-09, 10-16, and 17-24 handicap divisions respectively. Pradeep Mehra was adjudged Best Senior Golfer, while Dr. Anjali Jain won Best Senior Lady Golfer. Nitika Jadeja secured the Best Lady Golfer title. In the on-course contests, Sanjay Phophalia and Sunil Singh excelled in Nearest to Pin; Manoviraj Singh and Mohit Gothwal in Longest Drive; Eti Choudhary in Women's Longest Drive; and junior Kunal Singh impressed with the Straightest Drive.

PC Maheshwari Memorial Golf Tournament



The Rambagh Golf Club recently hosted the PC Maheshwari Memorial Golf Tournament (Monthly Medal – II), a two-day celebration of passion, precision, and sporting spirit. Held in honour of Late Shri PC Maheshwari, the tournament witnessed enthusiastic participation across categories, culminating in a spirited prize distribution ceremony.

Rishiraj Singh emerged as the Pro-Gross Winner, with Girraj Singh Khadka finishing as Pro-Gross Runner-up. The Amateur Gross Winner title was shared by Deepkaran S Thakkar and Nitesh Bandawala.

Other notable winners included Harish Joshi (Handicap 00-09), Drishavraj (Handicap 10-16), and Rajveer Maheshwari (Handicap 17-24), with Aarav Sacheti, Samranjai Singh, and M D Motwani finishing as runners-up in their respective categories. Pratap Singh was named Best Senior Golfer, Nirankar Singh received the Best Super Senior Golfer title, while Vrinda Saini and Nitika Jadeja were awarded Best Lady Golfer and runner-up respectively. In the skill categories, Ahaan Shah won Nearest to Pin, Abhyuday Rawat took Longest Drive, and Abhishek Raniwala claimed the Straightest Drive title.

Upcoming Tournament:

N.C. Datta Memorial Golf Tournament – Monthly Medal-III

The N.C. Datta Memorial Golf Tournament – Monthly Medal-III is scheduled for 19 and 20 April 2025. The tournament will follow an 18-hole Stableford format (3/4 Handicap, Maximum Handicap 24) and will be conducted across various categories, ensuring a competitive and enjoyable experience for golfers of all levels. Participants will compete in categories based on handicap brackets: 00-09, 10-16, and 17-24. There will also be dedicated categories for Veterans (65-75 years), Super Veterans (75+ years), and Ladies. In addition, Pro and Amateur Gross categories will be played over 36 holes across both days in a strokeplay format.

Tee-off will follow a shotgun format on both days. On 19 April, Veterans will tee off at 6:30 am for a 9-hole round (holes 1 to 9), followed by Ladies, 17-24 Handicap, and Playing Members at 7:30 am. An optional round may be held at 2:00 pm depending on the number of entries. On 20 April, players in the 00-09 and



10-16 Handicap categories will tee off at 7:00 am. Pro and Amateur Gross players will tee off at 7:30 am on 19 April and 7:00 am on 20 April.

The tournament is open to amateurs and professionals above 13 years of age, with specific recognition for senior and super senior players. A host of prizes will be awarded, including Gross Winners and Runners-up in both the Pro and Amateur categories, as well as Nett Winners and Runners-up in each handicap category. Special prizes will also be given for the Best Senior Golfer, Best Super Senior Golfer, and Best Lady Golfer.

On-course contests will include Nearest to the Pin (Hole #2), Straightest Drive (Hole #3), and Longest Drive (Hole #9) with specific awards for Overall, Ladies, and Veterans.


Later, Mr Vinay Modi briefed the caddies and further motivated them. Later, a 'prashadi' was also organised for them.
